

## Project K.N.O.T.S. is... Knowledge of Nature in the Outdoors Throughout Summer



KNOTS is a program designed for teenagers to continue their camp experience with challenging new activities and adventures. KNOTS goes on weekly field trips and incorporates hiking and other day trips around our great state of New Hampshire into their weekly schedules. They often spend time in the Franconia Notch area enjoying nature!

Campers may pack their own lunches (no glass) or have the lunch that is provided. Campers should also bring WATER BOTTLES, swimsuit, towel, sweatshirt,

bug spray, sunscreen, etc. Sneakers or hiking boots must be worn, absolutely no sandals are allowed at camp unless otherwise specified by director.

KNOTS participants are dropped off and picked up at the Newfound Memorial Middle School. All participants must be dropped off no earlier than 9:00 am, and picked up no later than 4:00 pm as they will only be supervised during those hours of camp.

BEFORE & AFTER CAMP: We have early hours (7-9am) & late hours (4-5:30pm) available each day for any parents who may need extended care. Before Camp costs \$6 per day & After Camp costs \$4 per day.

It is the policy of the TTCC to charge a fee for camp programs for the express purpose of covering expenses. It is also our hope that no area children be excluded from participating. Hence, a scholarship fund and volunteer work exchange program have been established in lieu of total payment. The TTCC tries to keep the cost at a minimum. The cost of camp in 2020 will be \$85 / week.

There is a \$20 registration fee in addition to the weekly camp fee, which includes a camp shirt. The camp shirt will be required for the campers to wear on field trip days so we can keep a better watch on all the children.
