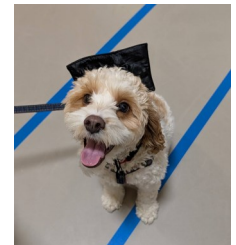

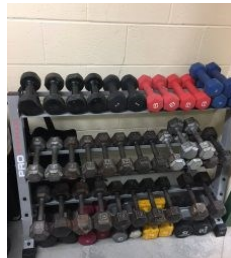

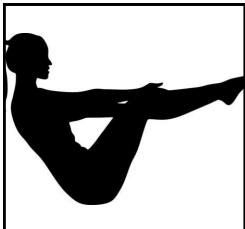

We Have Exciting News to Share!

The Bristol Recreation Advisory Council of the TTCC is thrilled to announce the purchase of the property at **90 Lake Street** (formerly Kathleen's Cottage), acquired in January 2026. For many years, it has been a dream of the Center to expand into a space that connects directly with Kelley Park. We are incredibly excited about what this new opportunity will bring to our community.

Our vision includes the development of a full-size gymnasium to better support the wide range of youth and adult programs we offer. While we will continue to cherish and utilize our current building, our programming has grown to the point where additional space is essential to meet community needs.

As we begin this exciting new chapter, we will be reaching out to Newfound residents for input on what features and amenities are most important to include in this new facility. Your feedback will help shape a space that truly serves our community.

We are also pleased to share that we have received **\$1.5 million in funding** through Senator Jeanne Shaheen's discretionary funds, allowing us to begin initial design and site work. In the meantime, the property is already being put to good use! Two batting cages have been installed and are seeing plenty of activity as baseball and softball seasons approach.

We are grateful to our donors that made this purchase possible! We look forward to this exciting journey and to creating a vibrant new community space for everyone to enjoy in the years ahead.

It is so important that we give a huge thank you to our many volunteers that help us to provide youth sports, staff events, and to help wherever needed. We could not accomplish all the good things we do without all of you! We are so incredibly blessed as TTCC will continue to be a place where community comes together.
